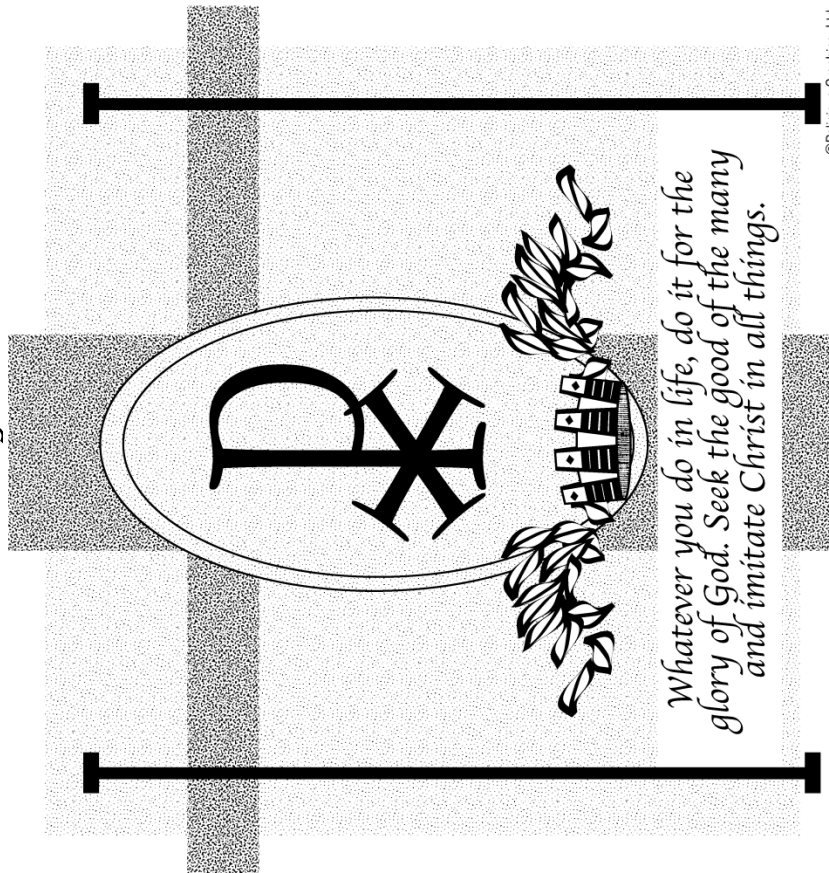

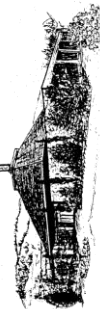

COMING EVENTS:

LENTEN STONES: You may have noticed a basket of stones as you came into church today: please take one as you leave. The stone represents the problems, sinfulness, and challenges that you carry. During Lent, place them in the stone. Think of that stone as if it were a sponge soaking up all these things that worry you. Carry it with you during Lent. On Good Friday, when you come to venerate the Cross, bring the stone with you. Put it in the basket at the foot of the Cross of Christ, and leave it there, giving the stone and all it holds into the care of Jesus on the Cross. Know that with his suffering, Jesus has redeemed you and given you the love and strength you need to face each day.

SUPPORT MISSIONARIES OF FAITH: Fr. Jojo’s Community has been given an orphanage (for use as a seminary) in India where Fr. Jose Michel is the Provincial. There are 17 seminarians who will be moving to the newly designated seminary. It has been suggested that we support the Missionaries of Faith and Fr. Jose Michel, as they renovate and furnish their new seminary. Therefore, after all Masses this weekend, 2 cup coin jars for spare change will be available outside of church. All jars will be collected on March 24th weekend (Palm Sunday). So we ask you during Lent to consider putting any spare change into the jars. Then for Easter we will let Fr. Jose Michel, Fr. Tom (Seminary Director) and the seminarians know of our Parish gift.
