



FAITH AFTER FIRES

Presented by: Fr. Jim Fredericks and Dr. Herb Anderson of the Catholic-Lutheran study group.

On Saturday, January 20th, from 9:30 - 11:00 a.m., in the Benziger Room, the Adult Education program of St. Leo's will present an opportunity to explore the sadness and anxiety and grief that linger after the fall fires. The program will be moderated by Fr. Jim Fredericks and Dr. Herb Anderson of the Catholic-Lutheran study group. Fr. Jim will return to a theme he presented in homilies during the wildfires, about the disaster as an Exodus experience. Evacuation is a form of exodus and the consequent homelessness for many people connects us with the world-wide phenomenon of refuges from fear and violence and starvation. The focus will then move to this question: How did the fires disturb your faith? Our aim is to explore the meaning of suffering that the fires evoked. The randomness of the fires makes it difficult to attribute them to God or some other agency. The aim of this conversation about suffering and calamity is to provide some new grammar of faith that people might use to talk about faith after fires. The session will include time for attendees to share their experiences, thoughts, concerns and questions.
